What is Gendered Disinformation?

Gendered Disinformation is a subset of Disinformation which specifically targets women in power. Through characterizing these women as overly emotional, sexual objects, or simply perpetuating misogynistic stereotypes, the attacker seeks to undermine the success, or capability, of their target, while disguising their misogyny as a political critique or opinion.

The Danger:

Those who do not *feel* as though they have bias towards women, may unknowingly share media that contains harmful/gendered content. Gendered Disinformation not only furthers unconscious biases but allows hateful individuals to share extremely harmful narratives without consequence.


Methods and Conclusion:

Through comparing the *content* and frequency of negative posts and applying Wardle's, Di Meco's, and Wilfore's theories of Disinformation, it is clear that women are disproportionately targeted, and that extremely sexist disinformation is employed to hurt their reputations.




