

#### **ANN COOPER HEWITT TRIAL:**

Ann Hewitt was nonconsensually sterilized after refusing to take an intelligence test. Her mother and the doctors then manipulated those results and deemed her mentally unfit (Kline, Farley).

Ann Cooper Hewitt's Trial shows that intersectional analysis reveals layered intent making it easier to find and prove disinformation





## A eugenics understanding of women

Mother of Tomorrow vs. The Moron

Modest	Overly sexual
Focuses on domestic duties	A gateway to "race suicide"
Protects white middle class dominance	Genetically flawed and unfit

Ideas taken from Wendy Kline's historical analysis of eugenics' gender ideologies (Kline 16-23)

#### Gender disinformation:

Desire to protect traditional female values



#### Racial disinformation:

Desire to protect white dominance



#### Intersectional analysis/disinformation:

False information being spread to achieve those gender and racial goals
