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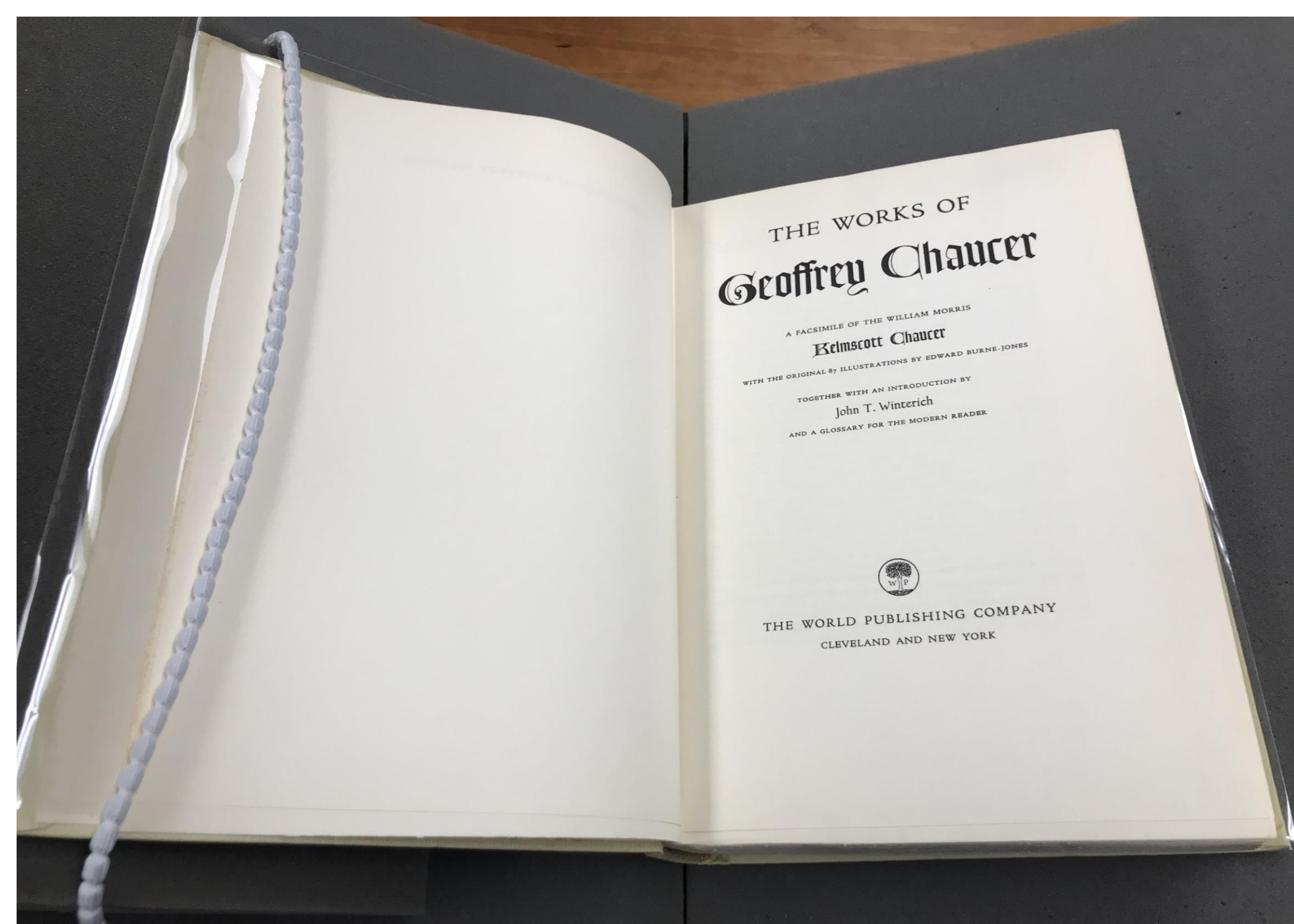
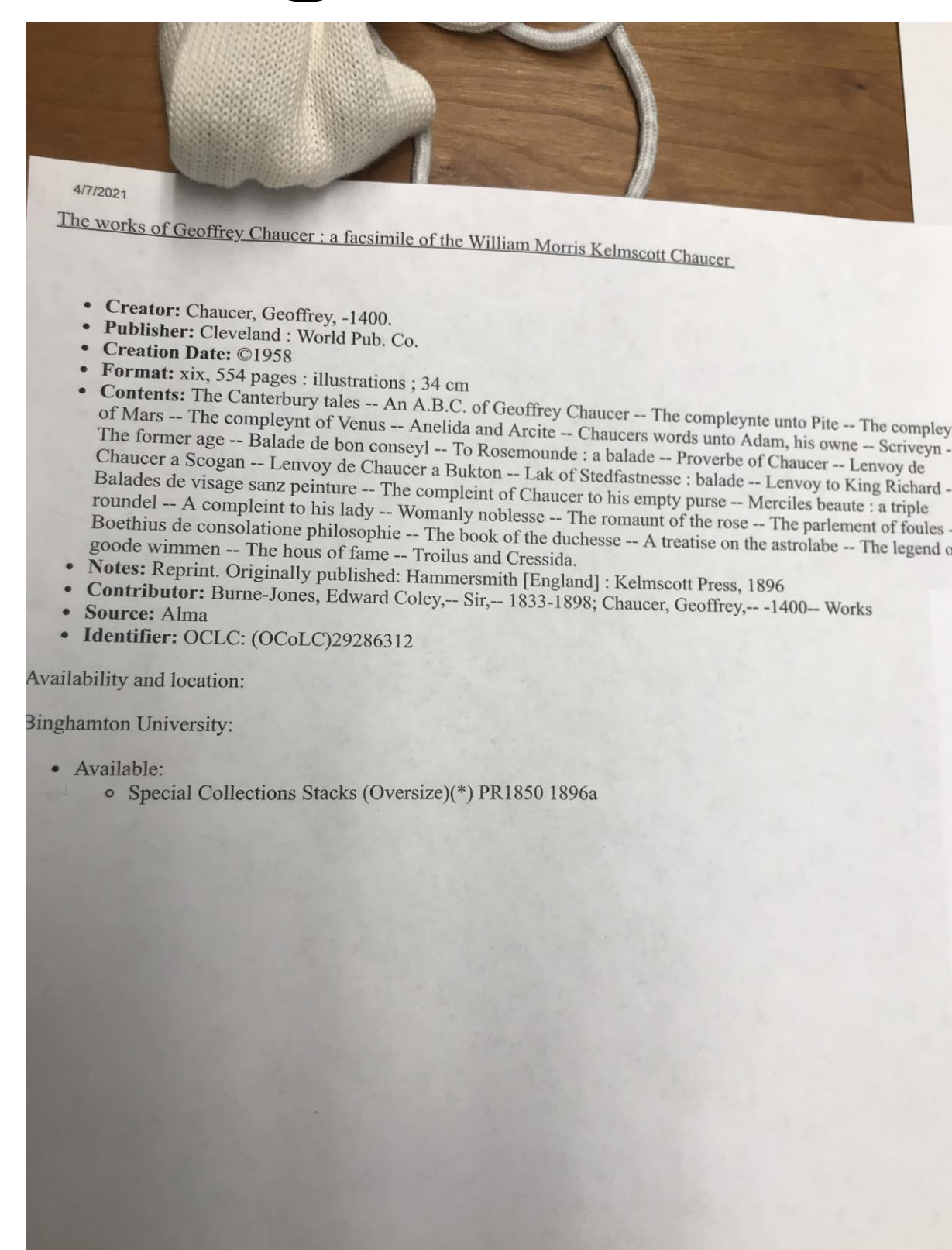

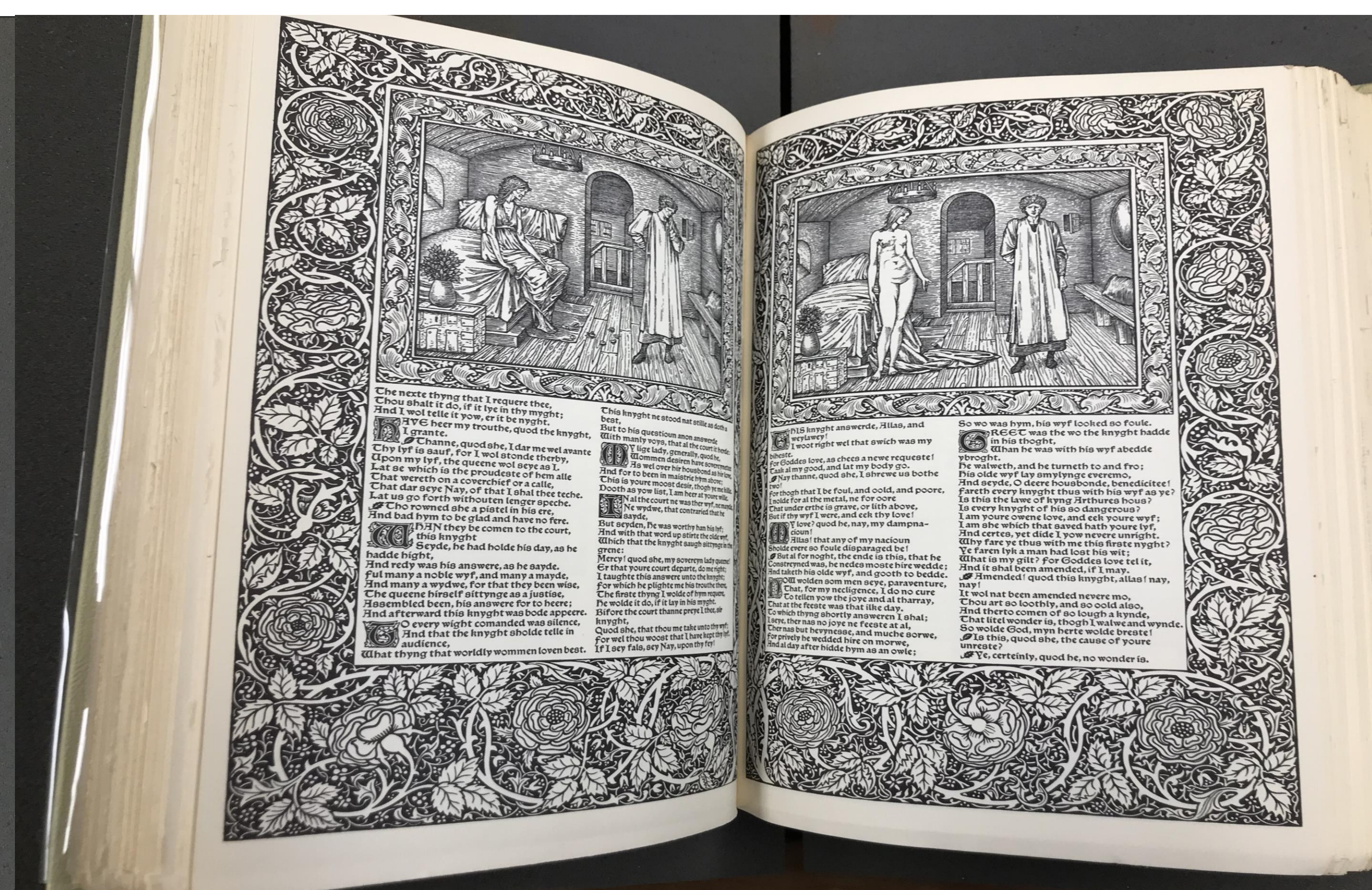

Introduction

- At the end of the 19th century, William Morris directed the publication of the Kelmscott Chaucer, a printed edition of Chaucer that took medieval manuscripts as exemplars.
- This study focuses on a facsimile located in the special collections at Bartle Library (PR 1850 1896a).
- Existing studies pay little attention to:
 - ❑ The paper and the palette, as well as their interaction with other decorative elements;
 - ❑ The audience;
 - ❑ Facsimiles
- My study, analyzing the interaction between the palette, the paper, and other decorations, examines what various audience get from the codex. I will also explore how the facsimile maximizes its efficiency in conveying messages from the original codex.

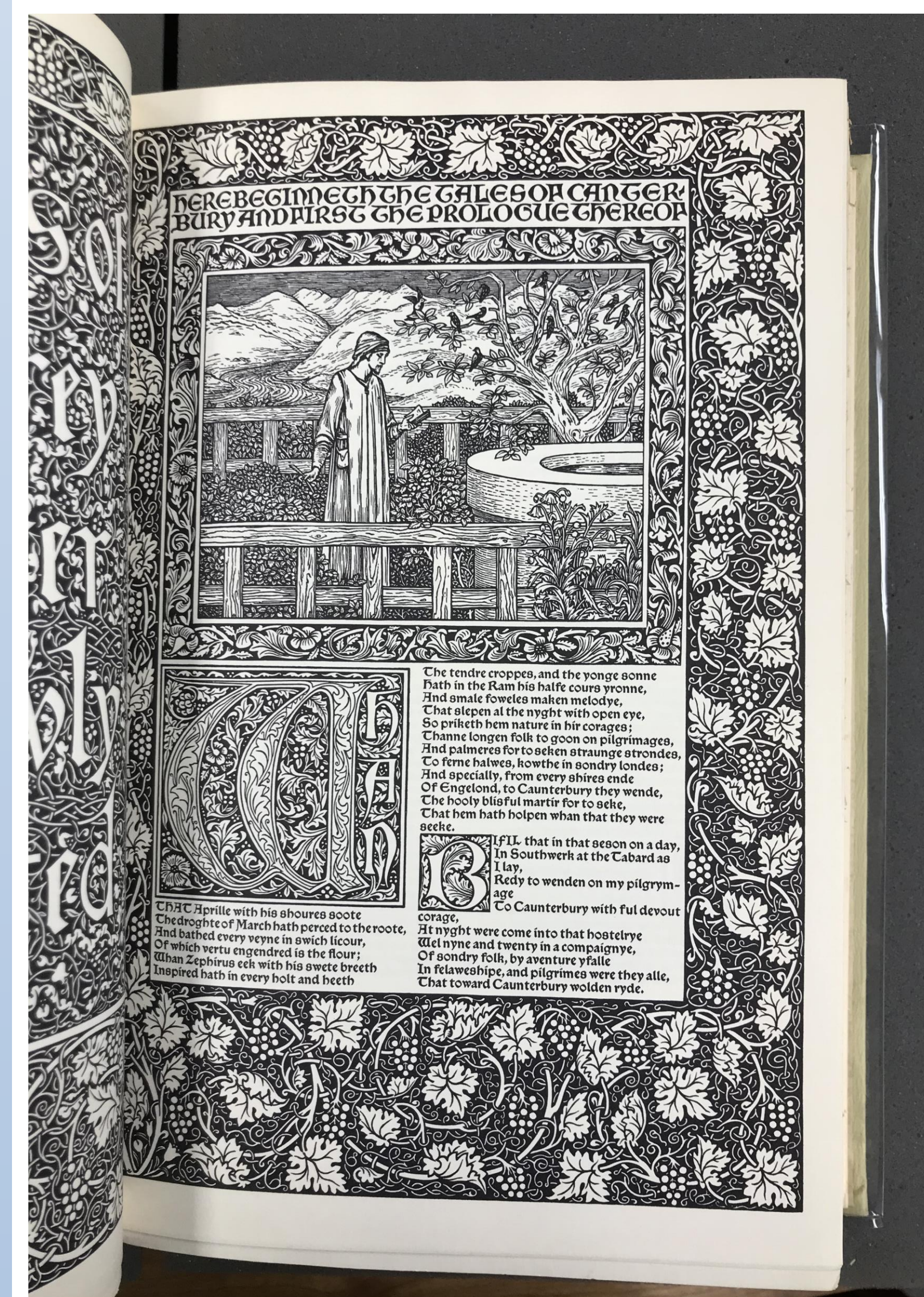

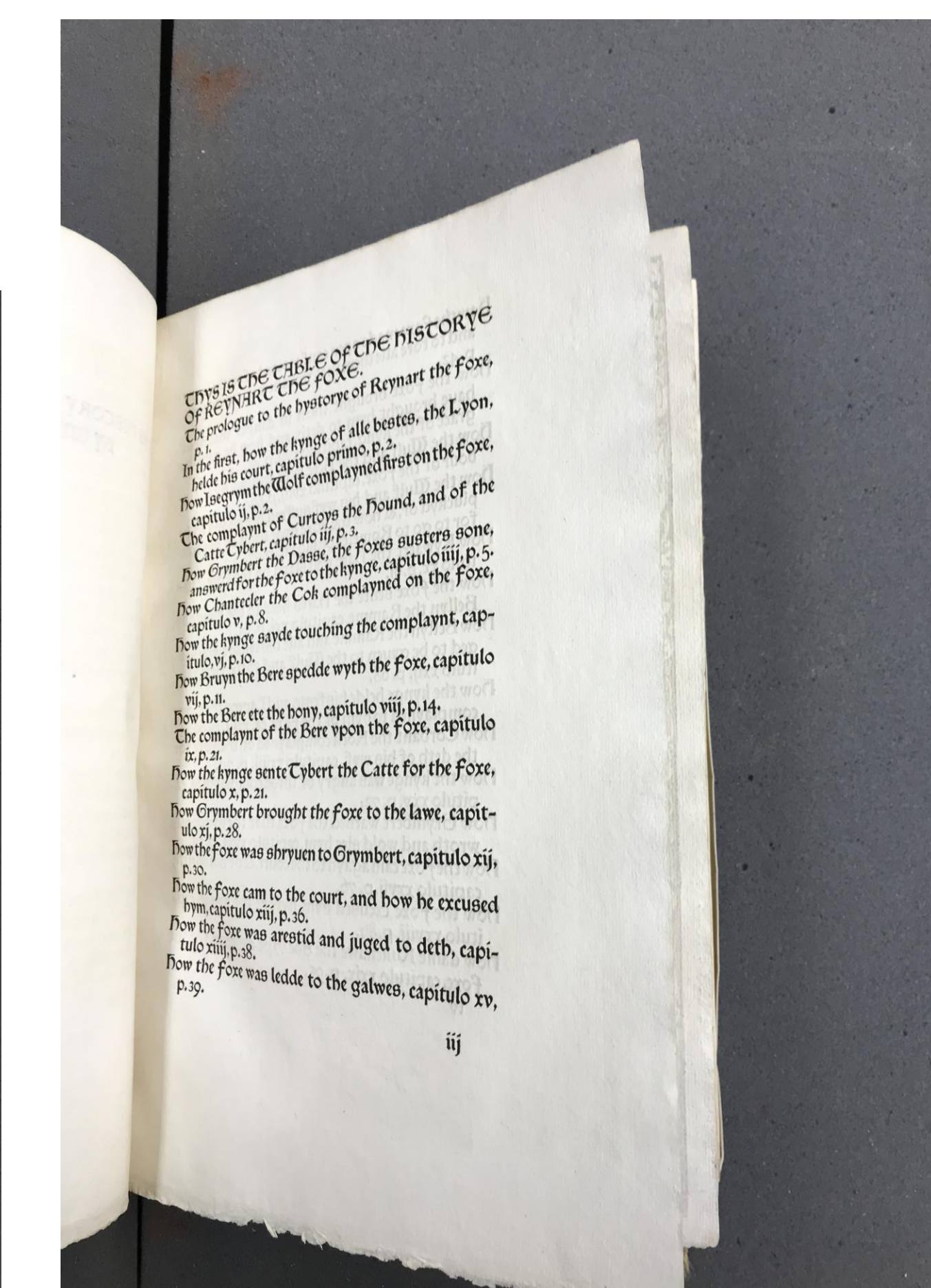


The Kelmscott Chaucer facsimile, "The Tale of the Wife of Bath"

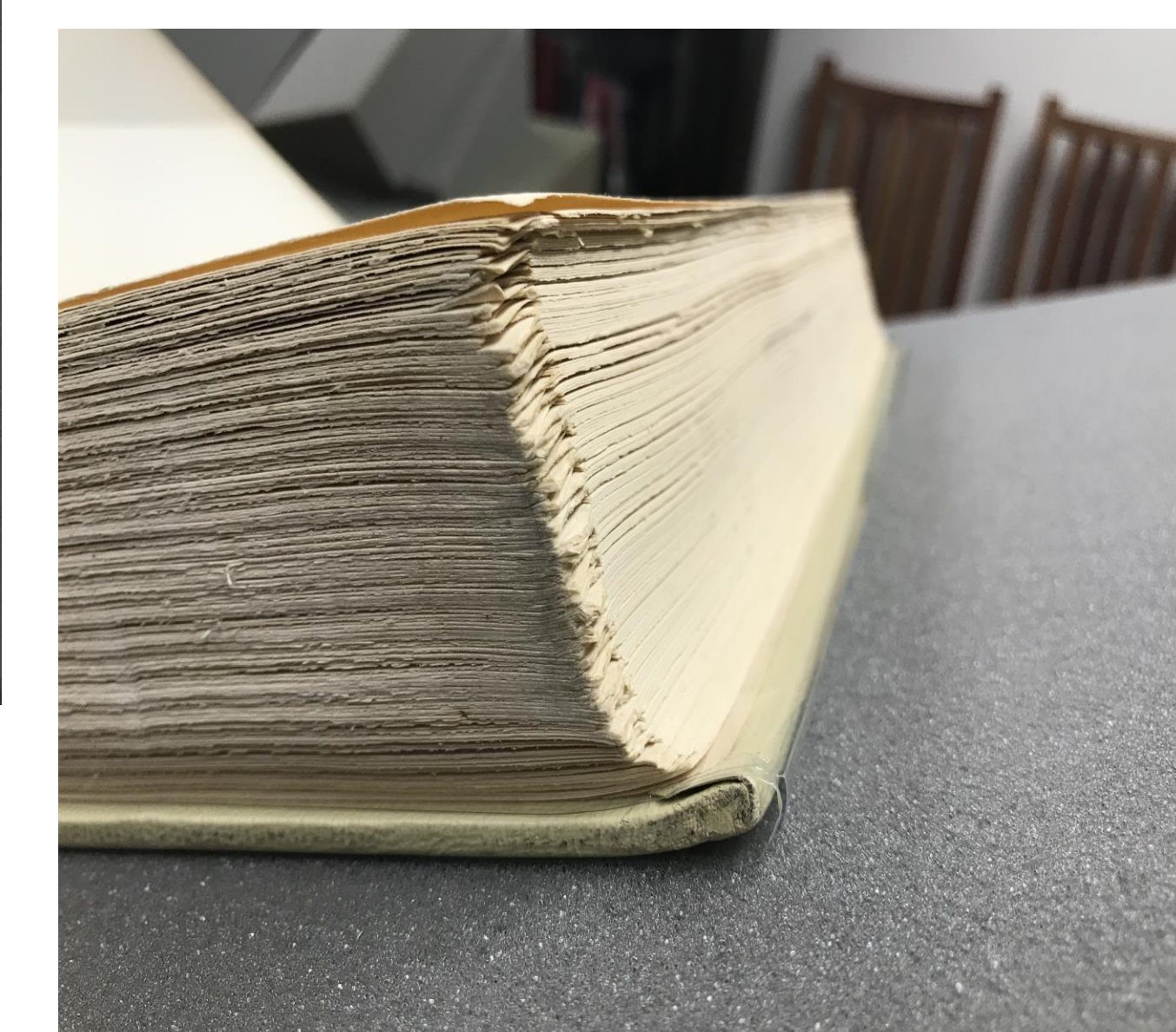
