Editor's Message

This issue marks the resumption of the journal of the Council for Northeast Historical Archaeology after a hiatus of two years. We will put out two issues a year, at least one of which will be based on a central theme. The next issue will be devoted to the early iron industry in America. The reader will be hard put to find a theme in this issue. The fact that all the articles are concerned with New York is only a coincidence.

One of the problems afflicting small journals such as this is a scarcity of quality manuscripts. The main purpose of this column is to call for papers. We need major articles to build up a stock of articles to flesh out thin volumes. Ideally, we will be working two issues, or one year, in advance of publication. This gives us the necessary lead time in case some problem arises which requires manuscript revision. We feel that it is unfair to authors for us to ask them to provide additional information and then not give them sufficient time to do a proper job.

Articles for Vol. 2, No. 2, will be due June 1, 1974. Short notes, photographs of items for identification or announcements will be due July 1, 1974. Comparable dates for Vol. 3, No. 1 will be December 1, 1974, and January 1, 1975. Manuscripts should be mailed to the editor at Fort Stanwix National Monument, 142 East Dominick Street, Rome, New York 13440.

The editor takes the responsibility for the contents but must acknowledge the invaluable assistance of Edward Heite in the production of this issue.
